- Carry out build of the electrical and electronic assembly(ies), in line with agreed schedule, to ensure on time delivery of project.
- Ensure the build is documented correctly following standard operating procedures.
- Integrate and calibrate H.E.L Instruments, following standard operating procedures and testing protocol
- Ensure an Electronics review is completed and address any shortfalls.
- Provide feedback for H.E.L's quality and continuous improvement system.

Other Duties

- Electrical admin tasks (eg. H.E.L Hospital repairs, works packages).
- Work with Purchasing & Stock Manager to ensure optimal Electrical stock levels are maintained.
- Deputise/cover for other Electronic Engineers as and when required.
- Deputise/cover for Line Manager as and when required.
- Take part in client site visits as and when required.
- Positively contribute to the efficient working of the Electronics and wider Project teams.
